The Chief Electoral Officer, Karnataka, Bangalore in his letter No..DPAR 02 CHURAGO 2013 dated:29.7.2013 has issued directions to declare 21st August 2013 i.e., the poll day as 'Paid holiday' for employees working in all organizations in order to enable them to exercise their franchise in terms of Section 135B of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 which provides for the grant of paid holiday to the employees on the day of poll. Since, bye elections to 20-Mandya and 23-Bangalore Rural Parliamentary Constituencies is going for poll on Wednesday, the 21st August, 2013, action may be taken to issue orders declaring Wednesday, the 21st August, 2013 as a 'paid holiday' in respect of the organizations coming under your jurisdiction.
