Portal open from 10 a.m on 15th December, 2018
- On challenge mode-the best institutes to be selected.

Eligibility

- Any recognized Higher Educational Institutions (Centre & State) willing to be involved in development activities.
- Should have at least 200 students.
- Willing to identify at least 5 villages in their vicinity.
- Should have at least 2 faculty members willing to involve with development activities in rural areas.

Mechanism

- Selected educational institutions to engage at Panchayat level in chosen villages.
- Assess need, formulate/Identify/Customise solutions-technological or otherwise.
- MHRD to assist in training and gap funding for technical solutions.
- MHRD's flagship program co-ordinated by IIT Delhi.
